Fr Mathew Street Improvement Scheme

8th January 2025

To Residents between the Dundrum Road Junction and the Knockanrawley Road Junction,

As you are aware from our previous flyers, Glas CEL are continuing work, on behalf of Tipperary County Council, for the N74 Fr. Mathew Street Improvement Scheme. Further to the flyer sent out before Christmas and given the adverse weather conditions currently being experienced, we now envisage the following with respect to traffic management / access / parking /works from Monday the 13th of January 2025:

- 1. The current one-way system on Fr Mathew Street will continue with traffic travelling completely on the RHS of the road whilst the Contractor constructs the new combined sewer pipeline on the LHS between the Dundrum Road Junction and the Knockanrawley Road junction. We ask that any residents with vehicles to please use the new car parking spaces on the RHS of the road and we will continue to accommodate existing pedestrian access to houses on the LHS of the road through our works area. Can residents have their vehicles parked as requested by next Sunday evening so we can divert traffic at 9am on Monday the 13th of January 2025.
- Between the 13th and 24th of January 2025 James Connolly Park Road will be closed on a full time 24/7 basis such that there will be no access to/from Fr Mathew Street – there will be a signed temporary diversion route in place for all vehicles. This closure is to allow reconstruction of this junction with the Contractor working longer site hours to achieve this tight deadline.
